However, during the waterproofing of surfaces using flame-distilled bitumen-polymer membranes, a limited airborne dispersion of potentially hazardous substances, including Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAHs), may occur. If applied in confined spaces without adequate ventilation, the concentration of these harmful substances in the environment can reach levels that pose an inhalation risk to exposed personnel.
